- First Energy Options
  - Does anyone have any suggestions to switch

- The electric has not went up as of yet, no one has any suggestions
- Planning Committee and Board of Zoning Appeals had first organizational meeting
  - Board of Appeals members and time frames
    - Bruce Bowman – 5 years
    - Matt Moser – 4 years
    - Carl Crisci – 3 years
    - Cindy Adkins – 2 years
    - Pamela Porter – 1 year
  - Planning Committee nominated 4 members plus Mayor
    - Board members can have one Council member

    - Martin Spearman – 3 years

    - Alena Carter – 1 year
  - The planning committee is a public meeting
  - Will need to review current Zoning Book and make suggestions for Change
  - Take current zoning book and use as a guide
- Village still needs a Maintenance Worker
- Firehouse Planning

**New Business:**

- Traffic Light Maintenance - \$550
  - Carl Crisci made the motion to have the Traffic Light Maintained with Jason Coey seconding the motion, all Aye – no opposed.

- County Commissioners have notified the Mayor that the Village has not been paying the Sewer Bill for the Office.
  - Does anyone know if there was an agreement that the village would not pay the sewer as part of the agreement for the County taking it over?
    - No One knows – the county took all of the sewer boxes.
- Drain/Grate in front of the Post Office needs looked at for it has popped out.
  - Will need to get estimates with contractors who does grates
  - Julie Griffith suggests Alan Fisher – (number provided)
  - Pam to get estimates for the drain/grate
- Tree leaning over Poplar Street at the McGuirk house.
  - Mayor to send a letter for them to take care of it
  - Council will look at estimate to have the tree trimmed
- Deb Jordan – issue with the Lawn Care Company blocking the alley by her house
  - Scott Jones from Great Scott is parking in the Alley blocking the road, parking in her yard and broke her sidewalk
  - Sheriff says they are not illegal
    - Need to have a report sent to Andrew Wick of the call
  - Solicitor suggests that we use the Village Patrol to see if there is a Pattern and catch them when it occurs
  - Get with council is on the road – Paula to contact them via a Letter.
