Approval May 28, 2024 Emergency Meeting Minutes: Beverly Moser made the motion to approve with the updates – change the date of the minutes with Alena Carter seconded the motion, all Ayes with no Opposed.

Approve Treasurers Reports for May 2024 – Pamela Porter made the motion to approve with Jason Coey seconding the motion with no opposed.

Next meeting will bring the Mid-Year budget due July 20th, Resolution 2024- 16.

Resolution 2024 – 15 New Declaring it Necessary to Proceed 4 Mil Levy – this will be a renewal of current levy which amounts for \$140 for each \$100,000. This levy will appear on the tax list for the next 5 years, 2025, 2026, 2027, 2028, 2029. The purpose of the levy is to support current operating expenses: Traffic and street lights maintenance, assist with emergency use such as Tree Pickup experienced after tornado – etc. Beverly Moser motioned the resolution with Martin Spearman seconding the motion.
