Pamela Porter noticed that Buckeye Paving used the leftover to fill in holes on North Street up by the Church. Jason Coey stated that Buckeye Paving started to strip the road on Mill street and said

Don Carr also received 2 estimates for Chimney repair – American Pioneer estimate was \$2,188.57 and Bill Connor was \$1550.00. It was asked if the Chimneys need to be saved, that if not would it not be cheaper to teardown and cap. Don and Jason will look at the Furnace to see if it is vented in those chimneys – Furnace needs Filters and also looks to be leaking – Furnace is Venting out the side of the house. Will reassess the Chimney repair.

Mayor Bowman will call Insurance to see if the Chimney and possibly a new roof can fall under the policy.
