Mayor Jerry Bloomfield called the meeting to order.

MINUTES for May approval – Motion to accept by Cindy Adkins and 2nd by Pam Porter all said aye – Motion Passed.

TREASURER Report approved for May - Motion to accept by Cindy Adkins and 2nd by Paula Bowman – All said Aye – Motioned passed

We are on target at 50% or below in allocation.

Monthly Bills approved to pay – Motion by Craig Weidman and 2nd by Cindy Adkins – all said aye – motioned passed.

Old Business:

1. Condemning of buildings – Reported by Andrew Wick – Working with Brent Russell – the revised code states that the buildings would need to be in tax trouble.
 - Sent email to Irrochi and prosecutors office
 - Continue to dig out the law books on where to go next
 - Continue working with Brent
 - Squires Street was a nuisance complaint – abated.
2. Health Department (Law Suit) – contacted insurance company – will have Andy cc'd on the progress.
3. Logo/Slogan – Picked up the survey box and online responses – will work with the committee and bring back to Council.
4. New Building Plans – Diane Weidman passed out the plans from the planning committee. The council reviewed the plans, Mayor Bloomfield is working with a firm on cost and development, which include grant writing. Will continue to keep the council informed.
5. Events Committee Report – Pam reported progress for Heritage Days – working with Church on the lawn, having Car Show – Art Show – Sandy Beckel will be in charge of the race – Parade up at school. Discussed having food trucks – Question was asked to see if that would take away from the church – the expectation is to draw in more people with variety and to try to build Heritage days up as it was before. Next meeting is July 1st at 7:00 pm.
6. Paving Estimate – Jerry reported on paving from 2 different vendors. He is going to collect more information and bring back to the next meeting.
7. Sidewalk Replacement – Jerry had an estimate from James Dean, he is going to look at a few more estimates before making a decision.
8. Trash Contract – Trash Pick-up would be \$20 for 96 gals can – there would also be a recycle bin. More to come on this project.
9. Annexation of Rock's Edge – Mr. Bonecutter is still in talks with Mayor Bloomfield. This will be a topic of further discussion.
10. Firehouse Restroom – There is repairs needed. John/Joelyn talked to the Fire department on fixing the restroom – Mayor Bloomfield has discussed with the Fire Department that they would need to fix, however John and Joelyn will be fixing – not sure of cost and material.
11. Other Old Business –
 - Camera's that were donated by Mr. Bonecutter will be put up one in the Village Office and the other on the Village Porch pointing towards the light. Tracey will be assisting in getting these functional.
 - Donation/Thank you Card to the Band – this was brought up at last meeting – the council will be getting a Thank You Card and having each council member sign.

No other OLD Business.

New Business –

1. 2020 Budget – The budget was passed out and discussed, this will be the mid-year budget for 2020 to send to the Auditors office due July 20th. A Motion was reintroduced on giving the Mayor a raise. This is being tabled for next meeting to discuss possible raise for Mayor to begin in 2020. Andrew will look at what other small municipalities are paying their Mayor to make the raise in line on how much to raise.
2. Trimming Tree's - The Mayor has received Estimates on trimming trees in the Village and needs the council to approve. The Mayor has one estimate from Tim Slone and will be looking to obtain more estimates from Always Chipper Tree Service – A motion by Craig Weidman to allow up to \$2000 to Trim Trees and 2nd by Cindy Adkins – All ayes – Motioned Passed for \$2000.00.

3. Mission Statement – Discussed the need to provide a Mission Statement for the Village – look at the Slogan/Logo – discuss at future meetings.
4. Web Site – Discussion was held on looking at changing the website and make it more productive and positive for the village. This is going to be discussed at future meetings – need to see what it will cost and who will be the Admin.
5. Other New Business – Kip would like to know if he needed a permit for a bigger awning to be put up – this will need to go through Brent Russell and will need a permit.
