- Approve minutes from January 2021 – There was an update made to Mayor Paula Bowman Presiding instead of President Paula Bowman Presiding motion by Cindy Adkins and 2nd by Don Carr – All Ayes – approved.
- Approve Treasure Report for January 2021 – in order to get January completed had to finalize the Year End – it has been posted Bank statement, Cash Report etc. were sent out via email for all to view motion to approve by Cindy Adkins and 2nd by Don Carr - All Ayes – approved.

Old Business:

- CORE Training - How to be aware about underlying Utilities – No one Attended.
- RCAP Training – Not for a small community
- Progress of Pantry Box

- Don Carr will be out of town and will have it completed when he returns.
- Deb Snell Checking with Church to put it there, but may be an issue with Liability – Library says we cannot put it there due to the liability if on their property.
- Council Jobs updates provided
 - Streets
 - Don Carr - No new updates at this time
 - Jacob Shaw - Denman Turnaround is the only thing to report.
 - Lights
 - Cindy Adkins – she checks the lights no issue.
 - Sewers/Storm Drains
 - Adding Beverly Moser to work with Pam Porter on Sewers
 - It was not Leon Holtrey – Pam will be checking to see who was on this. If it is along the Highway, may need to check with ODOT
 - Trees
 - Jason Coey – No update
 - CDGB
 - Bruce Bowman is working with Paula on the CDGB looking into getting someone on retainer cost about \$300 per month or a one-time fee for \$300
 - Joe Claus worked on the CDGB before he did not look at all of the grants but what was approved the Commissioners were awarded the grants
 - Jacob Shaw will check to see who Marengo Mayor has on retainer
 - Discussed Village Office, Sidewalks etc.
 - Look at the contract for Marengo for the legality of the Grant Writer

Clerk advised that because of the levy not passing this could be a strain on the budget for this year and possibly next year the cost for this could be \$3600.

- Maintenance person – snow removal for Village Office sidewalk
- Denman Avenue
 - Fence on the village roadway on Denman Ave will need to be removed as it is blocking
 - When will Mr. Adkins start building, no ETA but he is willing to do the dirt work for the extension of the Road.
- FEMA Training
 - Update: Don Carr has the reading completed and will take the test and bring in the Certificate to the Village Office
 - Jacob brought his certificate in to the Village Office

New Business:

- Community questions - 15 minutes will be set aside for this
 - Candi Crisci wanted to address the Village about the Denman Ave Vacating

Question as to why no one made a motion for the Vacate of Denman Ave, but the only thing that was brought up was about the roadway at the end of Denman inquiring about the top of Denman avenue about the 30 X 30 pad

The road was village road and can be put back to a motion If further discussion is warranted there will need to have all of the appropriate land owners are involved. Because we discussed this in December and No Motion to Vacate. This property is now un vacated.

Candi Crisci stated that the entire reason for the vacation was to correct it and now it is un-vacated it is wrong because a new owner moves in and you treat the village owners like this.

The road was vacated was vacated in 2017, the reason was for the vacation was due to the Village was not taking care of this.

The road was in the process to get corrected because the Engineers did not get the vacated paperwork was not submitted correctly

Candi's Point is that it was started to be corrected and she feels bad for the home owners and she doesn't like what the Village is doing to the homeowners

There will need to be a special meeting to address the issue and this would be all that will be discussed, if there are *new* items being brought up, if there is not a MOTION.


Could this be an hour before at 6:00 pm prior to the next meeting

Will need to give a month notice to be present to the meeting and provide updated information not already discussed prior with a time limit on discussion. Paula will decide the date and post the notice


Question – meeting at the town Hall with the meeting was recorded, due to it being in the town hall there was no recorder
