COUNCIL MEETING REGULAR SESSION CALLED TO ORDER AT 7:00 PM

COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF CHESTERVILLE

Mayor Paula Bowman called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM

Pledge of Allegiance was recited by all.

Approval August 15, 2024 Regular Session Meeting Minutes: Martin Spearman made the motion to approve the meeting minutes with Jason Coey seconding the motion, All Ayes with No Opposed

Approve Treasurers Reports for August 2024 – Beverly Moser made motion to approve with Pam Porter seconding the motion with no opposed.

Building/Zoning Inspector:

Inspection fees to be passed on to builder, usually by square footage of new build. Discussed what pricing fees are and how they are paid by other villages in area. Copy attached. Also added to fees for new builds would be funds for parks, snow removal, new lighting, etc.

Library purchased land adjacent to their building and plan to put in a park on that property.

Highland School property:

Township trustee sent a letter of interest to the Highland School Board. It was suggested that the Village of Chesterville not be in competition with them and support the Township in their efforts in obtaining the school property. The township has the same goal in mind for the public's use of this land.

Ohio Department of transportation sent letter with agreement attached for what ODOT is responsible for regarding the State routes that go through Chesterville. This includes painting of lines, placing of warning signs, snow removal of the State routes themselves. Agreement form needs to be filled out and will be submitted for a vote by Village Council next month.

Update of Fire Station:

Projected completion stands at approximately March, 2025.

At present there is a culvert across the sidewalk that will be removed and sidewalk will be ADA certified when work is done.

Franklin Township Meeting:

Voted not to allow Leaf Relief to open in their area. Leaf relief is asking for an exception to that ruling, which would then create a monopoly if approved.

Paving of Village streets: there are 4 streets that still need to be paved, but it is too late in the season to start now. This will need to be added to next year's budget to accomplish next year.

Snow Removal:

Agreement for the 2024/2025 winter season requires retainer of \$500.00.

Jason Coey put forth motion to accept agreement, Martin Spearman seconded.

Subject of sending notices of past due amounts due Village was discussed and it was agreed that these notices need to be mailed. Mayor Paula Bowman will take care of sending.

Fundraiser for Dawn Adkins:

Debbie Snell spoke about plans to have a fundraiser for Dawn to upgrade her house so that she will be able to function there. (ramp for entrance, lower counters for bathroom and kitchen, etc) and to help offset some of the medical expenses she will incur. It will be held April 12, 2025 and plans are already in place for areas around Chesterville that will be used during this event. This also includes

the church, town hall, and lawn behind Village offices. Sheriff's office will also be involved with security and traffic control. More details to come.
