

RESOLUTION #2021 – 05a
Three (3) MIL
RESOLUTION DECLARING IT NECESSARY TO LEVY A TAX IN EXCESS OF
THE TEN-MIL LIMITATION

The Council of the Village of Chesterville, Morrow County, Ohio, met in regular session on June 17, 2021 with the following members present: Don Carr, Jason Coey, Beverly Moser and Pam Porter with Mayor Paula Bowman presiding.

Jason Coey made the motion to pass the following Resolution:

Whereas, the amount of taxes which may be raised within the ten-mill limitation will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount for the necessary requirements of said Village of Chesterville, Morrow County, Ohio.

Therefore, be it Resolved, by the Council of the Village of Chesterville, Morrow County, Ohio, two-thirds of all members elected thereto concurring, that it is necessary to levy a tax in excess of the ten –mill limitation for the purpose of Current Expenses of the Village pursuant to O.R.C. 5705.19 (A), at a rate not exceeding three (3) mil for each \$1.00 of valuation which amounts to thirty (30) cents for each \$100.00 of valuation, for a period of five (5) years. Said levy will be placed on the November 3, 2021 election ballot.


Be it resolved, that said levy be placed upon the tax list of current tax year in compliance with the provisions of O.R.C. 5705.34, after the February settlement next succeeding the election, if a majority of the electors voting thereon vote in favor thereof.

Tax year 2022, 2023, 2024, 2025, 2026.

Be it further Resolved, that the Clerk of the Village be and is hereby directed to certify a copy of the Resolution to the Board of Elections, Morrow County, Ohio, and notify said Board of Elections to cause Notice of Election on the question of levying said tax to be given as required by law.

Certificate of Estimated Property Tax Revenue

The County Auditor of Morrow County, Ohio does hereby certify the following:

1. On June 24, 2021, the taxing authority of Chesterville Village certified a copy of its resolution or ordinance adopted on June 17, 2021 requesting the county auditor to certify the current tax valuation of the subdivision and the amount of revenue that would be produced by Three Mills 3 to levy a tax outside the ten mill limitation for Current Expense purposes pursuant to Revised Code 5705.19 (A) to be placed on the November 2, 2021 General election. The levy type is Replacement.

2. The estimated property tax revenue that will be produced by the stated millage, assuming the tax valuation of the subdivision remains constant throughout the life of the levy, is calculated to be \$9,632.00.

3. The total tax valuation of the subdivision used in calculating the estimated property tax revenue is 3,210,670.

Certified Date

1. "Total tax valuation" includes the taxable value of all real, personal, and public utility property in the subdivision which are on the tax lists that were most recently certified for collection. If the subdivision is located in more than one county, the home county auditor shall obtain the assistance of the other county auditors to establish the total tax valuation of the subdivision.
2. For purposes of this certification, "subdivision" includes any agency, board commission or other authority authorized to request a taxing authority to submit a tax levy on its behalf.
3. "levy type" includes the following: additional, renewal, renewal with an increase, renewal with a decrease, replacement, replacement with an increase, and replacement with a decrease levies.
4. Please file this certificate with the subdivision as soon as possible, so the taxing authority can pass a resolution to proceed not later than 90 days before the election.
