Old Business

- **Heritage Day report:**
 - Pam provided an update that Heritage days is going well, we have a band that is interested in coming and that the next meeting is August 19.
- **Trash Collection Village Wide:**
 - Mid-Ohio Sanitary to collect village residents' trash/recycle – Linda wanted to know why we are doing this – Response is that there are many different trucks picking up trash are damaging the streets in the village; Linda stated her streets are good only one pothole. She has B's out of Galion and pays \$20 p/month.
 - Carl C. spoke to folks in the area – he also uses B's and he doesn't think that the trash trucks are the real issue because they are not going fast... he feels that the telephone trucks cause just as much damage.
 - Were there bids that went out to all the Trash folks for bids. Recycle is another cost – of \$8.00. Carl did speak to B's and they would offer \$18.00 for Pick up.
 - Carl spoke to Cheryl Corbin, for Morrow, Knox, Delaware – concerning this and the recycle bin up in the old school area if trash is put in that they separate the trash out of it.
 - Carl is saying he does not like this and does not want to pay the cost for the trash. Wants to know what the legal ramification.
 - Andrew stated that the town has legal rights with a utility service and put in place.
 - Linda how are you going to ensure people uses the trash, and who will clean up the trash.
 - Deb understands how and why, but she thinks that the recycle should be optional and not a must have.
 - Andrew is putting in an ordinance for this.
 - Part of the issue is the recycling, public is putting their trash in Village cans and not having their trash picked up.
 - Call Mid-Ohio and work with Faith Kunze to discuss the recycle issue.
- Decision needs to be made if we continue forward or stop this? Contract is for 1 year, Jerry to look at phasing in the Recycling cost. Look into B's on recycle and trash BID.
- Visitor - Joe Jakubick from First Energy representing Ohio Edison – he passed out a flyer on how to report a Street Light Outing. Tracey sent him an example of the online request from Jerry.

- Need amount to move into the Trash, this will need a resolution. Would like a contract to pay X amount with or without recycling. Check on Dumpsters for the Businesses.
- Pam made motion to table the Trash, Cindy 2nd it.
- Resolution needed to appropriate Monies for the 2019 Fire Dept due to it not being paid by the Auditor until 2020. Pam made the motion and Cindy 2nd it.

- ODOT Paving of 95 through Chesterville
 - ODOT sent the Village cost of \$260,000 - \$265,000 the Village will need to come up with 10% to get grants – through ODOT. By Oct 4th need to submit the application and review the budget to come up with the 10%.
- Record Retention Policy Training – will be forth coming.
- Patty Roberts Letter concerning the Sidewalks and who is responsible to fix, response was that the owners are responsible. She is being told by her insurance company that the rocks on the sidewalks are an issue – the rocks are coming from the alley.
- **Slogan/Logo** – Need the council to decide so that the Events Committee can use the new logo and slogan to put on mugs to sell at Heritage Day. Discussion to pick a slogan – Suggestion of - Chesterville, Welcome Home or **Small-Town Big Hearts** or Live Real Live Rural Live Chesterville. Logo is a TREE with Hearts ON it.
- **Mission Statement TABLE to next month-**
 - Tracey sent out the start of a **Mission Statement** - The Village of Chesterville provides true core values in upholding the governance of the small hometown community to drive progress and best standards of living for the residents. **Vision Statement** - Build a United Community with engaged residents through growth, integrity, strength and partnership. **Core Values** – Integrity, Commitment, Accountant, Respect and Excellence.
