12” or more is \$850

Salt applied discussed if need to Haul Away it would be \$60 p/hour for Skid Loader and \$60 per hour for Dump Truck.

Second Estimate is TD Landscape

3" – 5.9" = \$262 p/occurrence
6" or more is \$105 p/hour
Salt Min of \$45.00
