Old Business:

- Trash contract is up for renewal, discussed the option to obtain a Senior Rate but not sure how to do it. Suggestions to see if there is a smaller Trash Bin or different color Trash Bin. Suggestions to request a 2 to 3-year contract to negotiate lower rates. Discussion will be held over to next meeting.

- Patrol increase from \$25 to \$27 - Morrow County Village Patrol is requesting to \$2.00 raise starting with he October Billing (for September) Contract is up in January, in the contract it does state to submit by October for the increase. Paula Bowman motioned to have the Village Solicitor to rewrite the contract to include the language that the increase request must be made by October but not will not be in the budget until January, Jason Coey second the motion – All Ayes.
- Dept. of taxation (income tax) - Did not discuss – Tracey is to find out the % Chesterville is paying RITA to collect.
- Appoint Paula Bowman as Pres. of Council due to Craig Weidman resigning from the the Council as President. Pam motioned the appointment and seconded by Don Carr – all ayes motioned passed.
- Halloween – Council recommended to have a Trick or Trunk up at the old school grounds from 5 to 6:30 on October 31st.
- Other New Business:
 - Mayor Jamie Bruckner of Mount Gilead father passed Village will be sending a card
 - Pauline Bowman 100th birthday – Clerk sent a card on behalf of the council and Jerry gave plaque
 - Oct 3rd will be a Soup Bean Dinner from 5 to 7 and a Movie after starting at 7:30 by the Store
 - Christmas in the Village – will decide by Nov


- Is it possible to have business owners on the council? Council members must live in the village; however, the business owners can come to the meetings. There can be an At Large Seat – if the owners come to the meeting this would not be needed. It is Ohio Law for the council to live in the village.
- Is it possible for the Village to obtain a Tornado Siren or Warning system? The village will need a grant to fund this, will need to get it through the County – will check with FEMA.


Adjourn Meeting - Don Carr motioned to Adjourn the meeting.
